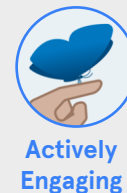

Mess-Free Practice with Whiteboard means:

- Less time spent on materials distribution and clean-up and more time spent **actively engaging** with content.
- Students use multiple “boards” as they engage in **deliberate and sustained practice**, thereby building a record of where they’ve been and where they’re going.

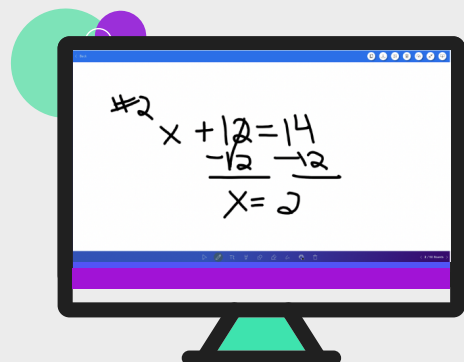
