

What is Multi-Task with Play Video or Pause Screen?

Multi-task with Play Video or Pause Screen enables the teacher to use their device even as students continue to actively engage with projected content. Teachers can project a performance task rubric while reviewing student learning data with an individual learner; play a content-based video while giving feedback on digitally submitted student work; or project a warm-up activity while completing attendance.

 Ensures students are actively engaging with content in a meaningful way while you reference learning data, prepare the next part of the lesson, or manage day-to-day operational needs.

Double-check the pause

Before you navigate to confidential information on your device, double-check that Pause Screen has been activated. You can do this by first navigating to a screen that doesn't contain sensitive information, while keeping your eye on the projected content.

Use pause to prep

 Pause Screen on a final practice problem while simultaneously teeing up a poll to gauge how students are feeling about what they've just learned.

 You want to increase your efficiency and secure privacy while students simultaneously engage with projected content.
