
Vivi Teacher Tip:

Share from Anywhere with Student Control





Bring learners' work front and center by projecting students' screens at the touch of a button. Student Control engages more students in sharing because they can do it quickly and easily from the comfort of their seat — or anywhere else in the classroom!

Research Connections:

Share from Anywhere with Student Control supports research-based instruction because it...

- Offers students **greater choice and agency** by giving them the opportunity to share their work directly with classmates at the touch of a button.
- Promotes peer learning and collaboration by giving all students not just those who may be eager to come to the front of the classroom – the opportunity to share their work with their peers from the comfort of their own spaces in the classroom.

Check names and preview screens

 When students request to share, take a moment to preview their screen before giving them control to share their screen

Try this strategy when...

- You want to showcase students' work without the fuss –
 no erasing existing notes to create more whiteboard real
 estate, switching projectors or screens, or erasing
 students' work so that you can continue on with the
 lesson
- You want to encourage more hesitant participants to share, engage, and collaborate with their classmates.


