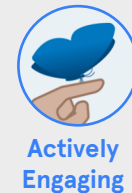

Ensure Vivi rooms are in the same location

- To pair rooms, Vivi boxes must be on the **same network**, and the **paired rooms must be in the same location in Vivi Central**. Up to 10 rooms from the same location can be combined in this way.

Try this strategy when you want to...

- Use space more flexibly by eliminating the “front” and “back” of the room
- Gather a **larger roster of learners** together (e.g., unit kick-off, culminating experience) and ensure everyone has a “front-row” seat
- Transition seamlessly from **large-group to small-group** work. Try syncing all screens to ensure everyone has a front-row seat during large-group time and then unsyncing screens to give control back to small groups as they collaborate

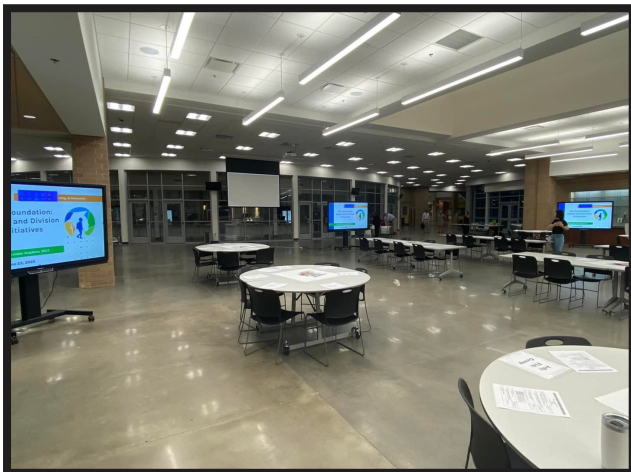

Professional Learning with Surround Screen

Henrico County Public Schools in Richmond, Virginia uses Surround Screen for professional learning engagements. All screens are synced so that every educator has a front-row seat during large-group time. Then, facilitators unsync screens and give control to small groups of educators for collaborative small-group time.
